Description of (i) The enhancement, issue or defect which this Change Proposal seeks to address, or (ii) the modified or new charging method or charging structure required pursuant to this Charging Change Proposal, as required under the Market Arrangements Code Section 6.2.1(b).	
<p>This Change Proposal seeks to provide clarification amend issues with respect to CSD 0101:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> CSD 0101 section 2.2.22 allows for the resubmission of T139.W and T140.W prior to the SPID becoming Tradable if the applicable Service Components, and the Tariff to be applied to each active Service Component, need to be modified. However, it is not clear that when resubmitting these transactions, any values previously submitted will be replaced. <p>Consider the following scenario. On the initial submission of the T139.W, MPW (Metered Potable Water Services) and AW (Assessed Water Services) service components are submitted. Following this, the Wholesaler resubmits the T139.W with only the AW service component. The expected behaviour of CMOS is that it will remove the previously submitted MPW service component and leave only the active AW service component. This change will ensure that the Market Codes are clear on this behaviour.</p> CSD 0101 contains provisions for when certain meter related data items need to be provided. These rules are based on the type of meter that is being installed. Section 2.2.32 (b) states that for a Private Water Meter or Cross Border Meter, the Water Chargeable Meter Size shall not be provided by the Wholesaler, as it will be set to zero by CMOS. <p>However, CSD 0101 does not state which meter related data items need to be provided for Non-Market Meters. This change is required to clarify which data items need to be submitted by the Wholesaler on the T104.W, and which data items are set by CMOS.</p> <p>Non-Market Meters are potable water meters (domestic meters), for which TP's need to provide data similar to that provided for Potable Water Meters. Therefore, any sections that refer to Potable Water Meters, also need to include a reference to Non-Market Meters.</p> The name of transaction T115.W is incorrect in section 3.2.2 and needs to be updated. Amend the layout Appendix A.2 of CSD 0101: The layout of appendix A.2 (the table formatting) makes it difficult to clearly understand the validations performed by the Market Operator under each step. This is due to missing 	

semicolons (;) and the rows in the table not being as clearly delimited as possible.

5. The Data Owner and Transaction name are incorrect at step (o) of Appendix A.2. This step should refer to the T132.R (instead of the T132.W which does not exist), as it is a Retailer transaction.

Description of the Change Proposal/ Charging Change Proposal, its nature and purpose and (for Change Proposals only) how it is consistent with the Principles and falls within the Objectives noted below, as required under the Market Arrangements Code Section 6.2.1(c).

From the issues identified in the section above, the following amendments are proposed to CSD 0101:

1. **Amend section 2.2.22 to:**

The Wholesaler shall notify the Market Operator in respect of the applicable Service Components, and the Tariff to be applied to each active Service Component, using Data Transactions T139.W (Submit Water Services SPID Service Components) and/or T140.W (Submit Sewerage Services SPID Service Components). For the avoidance of doubt, these Data Transactions may be resubmitted prior to the SPID becoming Tradable if the applicable Service Components, and the Tariff to be applied to each active Service Component, need to be modified, **and will replace any values previously submitted**. After the SPID has become Tradable all such modifications shall be made using Data Transactions in accordance with CSD 0104 (Maintain SPID Data).

2. **Amend section 2.2.32 step (a) to:**

for a Potable Water Meter ~~or a~~, a Non-Potable Meter **or a Non-Market Meter**, the Return to Sewer and the Sewerage Chargeable Meter Size shall not be set to any value by the Water Wholesaler submitting the Data Transaction, as the Return to Sewer will be set by the Central Systems to the Default Return to Sewer value for the Sewerage Wholesaler, and Sewerage Chargeable Meter Size will be set to the Physical Meter Size by the Central Systems. These Data Items may subsequently be changed only by the Sewerage Wholesaler;

- Amend section 2.2.33 to:**

The Wholesaler will also include within Data Transaction T104.W (Submit Meter Details) meter location data, data logger flags to indicate the presence or absence of data loggers (or similar device for data capture and transmission) at a meter, the Physical Meter Size and the Meter Addition Reason. The meter location should be notified in the form of Ordnance Survey Great Britain (OSGB) X and Y co-ordinates in an all-numeric format and should also include a Meter Location Code, an address and optionally a free text location description. Likewise, if a meter outreader is installed, the meter outreader location should be notified in the form of OSGB X and Y co-ordinates in an all-numeric format and should also include a Meter Outreader Location Code and optionally a free text location description. Data loggers can be either Wholesaler data loggers or non-Wholesaler data loggers. Both data logger types can be present at a meter at the same time. The Wholesaler will also identify if the meter installation was undertaken by an Accredited Entity. The Physical Meter Size must be provided for Potable Water Meters, Non-Potable Water Meters, Private Water Meters, ~~and~~ Cross Border Meters **and Non-Market Meters**. Otherwise, the provision of the Physical Meter Size is optional.

3. Amend section 3.2.2 to:

If a SPID has been Registered in error, it is the responsibility of the Wholesaler to submit an appropriate T115.W (Declare Disconnection/Reconnection/**Deregistration**) Data Transaction to Deregister the SPID.

4. Amend the Market Operator data validation in Appendix A.2 to:

Improve the layout of Appendix A.2 (b) by introducing commas (,) and semicolons (;), and introduce a clarification sentence in A.2 (b) "**Valid Reason Code provided.**"

5. Amend the Data Owner and Transaction in Appendix A.2 at step (o) to:
