



Panel Meeting 43 – Headline Report

26 May 2020

This Headline Report provides a record of the decisions made by the Panel.

1 CPM027/CPW098 (Extending Suspension of Performance Standard Charges due to Covid19) - Draft Recommendation Report

The Panel considered the Draft Recommendation Report for [CPM027/CPW098](#). This Authority Timetabled Change Proposal sought to extend the suspension of the requirement for the Market Operator to invoice charges for Market Performance Standards (MPS) and Operational Performance Standards (OPS). This followed the implementation of [CPM023/CPW090 'Suspension of Performance Standard Charges'](#) on 23 March 2020 and, if implemented, would extend the suspension to include June and July 2020, or any other period as the Authority may determine.

The Panel:

- **AGREED** to recommend CPM027/CPW098 to the Authority for approval (unanimous); and
- **AGREED** to recommend an implementation date of 1 June 2020.

2 CPM025/CPW097 Suspension of Performance Standard Charges Following Interim Supply Allocation – Draft Recommendation Report

The Panel considered the Draft Recommendation Report for [CPM025/CPW097](#). This Authority Timetabled Change Proposal sought to suspend the requirement for the Market Operator to issue invoices for, and Retailers to pay, Market Performance Standard (MPS) Charges for any Interim Duty Supply Points allocated to them for the three months following an Interim Supply event.

The Panel:

- **AGREED** to recommend CPM025/CPW097 to the Authority for approval (unanimous); and
- **AGREED** to recommend an implementation date of 1 July 2020.

3 CPW080 (Simplification of the Default and Termination Process) – Draft Recommendation Report

The Panel considered the Draft Recommendation Report for [CPW080](#). This change sought to simplify and clarify the Default and Termination Processes for Wholesalers and Retailers.



The Panel:

- **AGREED** to recommend CPW080 to the Authority for approval (10 in favour, 1 against, 1 abstained); and
- **AGREED** to recommend an implementation date of:
 - 28 August 2020, if Ofwat approval is received by 5 August 2020; or
 - 6 November 2020, if Ofwat approval is received by 14 October 2020.

4 CPW087 (Ability for Wholesalers to add meter reads) – Draft Recommendation Report

The Panel considered the Draft Recommendation Report for [CPW087](#). This change sought to allow (not oblige) Wholesalers to submit non settlement affecting meter reads into CMOS from Loggers, Automatic Meter Readers (AMRs), Smart meters, bilateral requests, difficult to access meters and leak detection work. If implemented, this would facilitate Retailers in gathering readings, improve the market dataset and reduce the number of Long Unread Meters.

The Panel:

- **AGREED** to recommend CPW087 to the Authority for approval (unanimous); and
- **AGREED** to recommend an implementation date of:
 - 6 November 2020, if Ofwat approval is received by 19 June 2020; or
 - 14 May 2021, if Ofwat approval is received by 12 November 2020.

5 Review of Industry Level Estimates

1.1 The Panel considered a review of the Industry Level Estimates (ILEs) as provided for in CSD 0207.

1.2 The Panel:

- **NOTED** the contents of the paper;
- **AGREED** that no changes to the ILEs were required (unanimous); and
- **AGREED** to review the ILEs in the first quarter of the financial year 2021/22 (unanimous).
